building relationships between people of different backgrounds through sports, and we're excited to partner with them as our December Referral Rewards Partner! The organization coordinates volunteers to travel to developing nations to build basketball courts. These trips create dynamic partnerships between the communities receiving the courts and the volunteers who travel to build them.

Courts for Kids began when a community in the Philippines reached out to founder, Derek Nesland, and asked that he travel to build a basketball court. The courts can be used throughout rainy seasons when soccer fields flood. Derek and his wife, Selene, both Vancouver natives, recognized the opportunity to bridge cultural barriers through the universality of sports and created an organization that emphasized global understanding. The nonprofit recruits volunteers, often young adults, and teams up with communities that would benefit from a basketball court. The team then travels to build the court with help from a local construction company to strengthen ties between the volunteers and the community and to stimulate the local economy. The groundwork is laid by the local company before the volunteers arrive, and the team then works for the next few days to complete the court and give it to the community. One of the most important components of the trips is the cultural exchange that takes place between the local communities and the volunteers. In addition to working on the courts, volunteers stay with locals and are fully immersed in local culture. Selene comments, "It's important that we're not viewed as Americans coming to do things for a community but rather with a community... We believe that every North American should have an immersion experience in the developing world." Courts for Kids also promotes gender equality and

"
