Their adoption, education, and clinical and care services are supported by gifts from generous, caring friends like you.

Some Quick Facts about what the Humane Society for Southwest Washington was able to accomplish in 2013 alone:

*80,305 Pounds of Dog & Cat food consumed, 8,438 Animals were Served, 3,505 Adoptions, 1,982 strays received from Vancouver, 528 Active Volunteers, with an average length of stay at 13 days.*
