Featured Non-Profit Organization: FISH of Vancouver

This April we are proud to be partnering with a nonprofit that has served our community for more than 45 years, FISH of Vancouver! FISH stands for Friends in Service to Humanity and they are guided by the statement "Feeding Families. Nourishing Children." This non-profit provides nutritionally balanced food to hungry families and individuals of all ages in times of emergency. FISH is able to provide a 3-5 day supply of food once a month to families. Each month, more than 5,000 men, women and children are provided with emergency food and 37% of recipients are children.

FISH is located in West Vancouver (906 Harney Street) which has the lowest income level in Clark County. FISH of Vancouver is run by volunteers and funded entirely by donations. There are currently more than 70 volunteers, some of whom have been serving with them for more than 20 years With the help of these volunteers, FISH is able to serve those in need Monday through Friday from 10AM to 3PM.
