Through the foundation's support, elementary students receive the mental, physical and social aid needed to thrive both in school and in their homes and greater community. The Hough Foundation provides resources that enhance the wellbeing of students and their families and strategically intervenes to find the best solution when needs arise. Jill Campbell, executive director of the foundation says, "Students leave Hough School life-ready and education-ready, empowered to actively engage in a world they help create."

Paul Christensen, the foundation founder and a former Hough student, recognized the value of his early education at Hough. For the past 24 years, Christensen and the foundation have worked to promote early childhood development and support Hough families. Through grants, fundraisers and individual donations, the foundation is able to accurately assess and listen to the specific needs of students, families and staff. One of their main goals is, "to hear what our families and community needs and to hopefully support their needs with action and funds." This attention to the real needs of teachers, students and their families allows the foundation to tailor their support to the Hough community so that problems are given direct solutions.

The foundation coordinates volunteers and listens to teachers' thoughts and needs to ensure they receive support in helping their students. Volunteers help teachers in clerical duties, serve as tutors and mentors and engage with individual students through The Lunch Buddy program, a program in which volunteers are paired with Hough students who would benefit from one-on-one mentorship. These volunteers help the school provide attention and resources to the needs of each student and dedicate more than 10.000 hours each year. Services provided in the last year include a healthy snack program, one-on-one counseling for students and parents, rental assistance for Hough families and salary assistance for an all-day kindergarten teacher and special education teacher. And the foundation has gave the school a therapy dog, Luna, whose presence teachers have noticed has led to a 30-50% faster de-escalation rate from a stressful situation.

Two after-school programs have been created, the Glee Choral Group and Escola de Samba, which give students additional care and encouragement outside the classroom. Through singing and Brazilian style drumming, the programs give students the opportunity to perform for their friends and family onstage, which, in turn, increases self-confidence and pride. Students involved in these after school programs tend to have increased attendance and improved grades.

The Hough Foundation also supports the specific needs of their students' families. Mental
