Here are just a few of the invaluable programs the Parks Foundation provides:

Sensory Camp is a seven-week summer camp carefully designed to provide elementary school children with Sensory Processing Disorders a place to be themselves in a positive camp environment.

The Battle Ground Veterans

Memorial was dedicated in 2015. The memorial is engraved with the names of 31 honored veterans, "local service men who died in service to our country." You can recognize a veteran in your life by purchasing a brick to be engraved and placed at the memorial. Funds raised through these brick sales help to pay for memorial maintenance and operation.


